## Travel Abroad with Nationally Competitive Scholarships

### Boren

Study less-commonly-taught languages in the context of international study abroad. These scholarships are available to undergraduate students and are applicable to a variety of world regions. Awards include funds up to \$20,000 for study. A service obligation is required.

### Charles B. Rangel International Affairs Fellowships

A new award for two years of graduate study or professional schooling in international affairs, these awards include up to \$28,000 in annual scholarship funds, as well as additional support for an internship in Washington, D.C. and at a U.S. Embassy overseas. A service obligation is required.

### DAAD Scholarships

DAAD is the German Academic Exchange Service, which supports international cooperation in academics with the U.S. Scholarships differ but support individuals from undergraduates to post-doctoral scholars.

## Gilman

The Gilman Program prepares students, from financially disadvantaged backgrounds, for a role in the changing global economy. Scholarships are awarded as funds up to \$5,000; additional funds for critical language study are available up to \$3,000.

## Marshall

Tuition and personal stipends are given to students to pursue a graduate degree in any field at any British college or university for two years. Seniors and graduate students with at least a cumulative GPA of 3.7 are eligible to apply.

## NSEP Flagship Language Fellowship

Arabic, Mandarin, Persian, Korean, and Russian study are funded by this program geared towards areas of national interest. The Fellowship pays for students' participation in the two-year Flagship Language Program, and stipends are based on the location of individual placement for language learning. A service obligation is required.

## Rhodes

One of the nation's most prestigious awards, Rhodes Scholarships fund tuition, travel, and living expenses for up to three years of undergraduate or graduate study in any field at the University of Oxford.
